The Bucks County Crimes Against Older Adults Task Force has implemented a [Fraud Alert](#) system of monthly alerts. These Fraud Alerts are designed to communicate ongoing fraud prevention information as well as raise the awareness of the latest scams, frauds, and consumer abuse.

Fraud Alerts are designed to be sent via a broadcast e-mail, with postal delivery or broadcast fax available to those without e-mail.

Bucks County Crimes Against Older Adults Task encourages seniors, caregivers and professionals who work with older adults to become a CASE Fraud Alert partner.

As a Fraud Alert partner, you will receive the monthly Fraud Alerts on the first business working day of each month. The goal is for you to then disseminate the alerts to your friends and networks as quickly as possible. Speed is important because the information contained in the alerts can help your members avoid becoming victims of crime. We suggest you share this information in more than one way: newsletter, worship bulletin, e-mail, bulletin board, etc.
